

# ART key stage 3 – Summary of Units 2012/13

At Key Stage 3 all pupils follow a broad and varied scheme of work that aims to provide students with a range of skills that allow them to develop and mature as they progress through the school. Students work in sketchbooks and produce final pieces in paint, mixed media, print and 3-dimensions. It is hoped with this grounding they can become more confident and independent artists when they move into Year 10. Students have one lesson a week.
