- Please notify the school office either by phone or email with the date and time
- Routine appointments absent from school for an appropriate length of time to attend the appointment.
- Whole day absence we will require a copy of the appointment letter or card. (Without this evidence we may be unable to authorise the absence)

Holidays

 We are no longer allowed to authorise days missed due to holidays except in exceptional circumstances (such as the terminal illness of a family member).

If your child is absent and you have not made contact with us by 9.15am, we:

- will telephone or message you via Edulink if we have not heard from you this is because we have a duty to ensure your child's safety as well as their regular school attendance
- may invite you in to discuss the situation at an Attendance Improvement Meeting (AIM)
- will refer the matter to the Herefordshire Council if there are 10 or more unauthorised absences, this equates to 5 school days as there are 2 sessions in each day. We may also refer the matter to Herefordshire Council where there are continued unauthorised absences.
